

Cigre 2004 General Session

Call for Papers from U.S. Authors

Deadline: 1 April 2003

The Cigre 2004 General Session will be held 29 August-3 September 2004 in Paris, France. The Technical Committee of the U.S. National Committee of Cigre (USNC Cigre) invites U.S. authors to prepare and submit papers for the session. As in the past, the USNC Cigre has a quota of 10 papers for this meeting. The Technical Committee of USNC will review all the submitted papers and select the U.S. portfolio of papers. The papers should meet the following criteria:

- Be of the highest technical standard and not published elsewhere
- Address one or more of the “Preferential Subjects” given on the Cigre Web site, <http://www.cigre.org/GB/IMEETINGS/fsIM.htm> (Each paper must clearly identify which preferential subjects it addresses).
- Limited to six pages in length in the Cigre format (Format specifications are available at, <http://www.cigre.org>).
- Be accompanied by a (minimum) 500 word abstract (Abstracts of less than one page in length are not acceptable).
- Must reach the USNC Cigre Technical Committee chair by 1 April 2003 (This deadline will be strictly enforced).
